School Uniform

Children may return in September in summer uniform.

A general reminder below on uniform and hairstyles:

School Togs provide our school uniform (ties, red jumpers, cardigans, checked dresses and skirts)

Girls: Navy or red tights. Boys: grey trousers or shorts.

School shoes: Black shoes (buckle, lace or velcro fastening). No trainers.

Boys: No extreme haircuts (short sides and long on top), no shaved lines or patterns.

Boys & Girls: Wear long/shoulder length hair tied up and/or use clips or hairband to hold back hair from the face.

PE kit: **Black shorts (not cycling/lycra shorts)**, white t-shirt, trainers (no pumps for PE), navy jogging bottoms and sweat top for the colder weather.
