Congratulations to our Year 6 pupils and parents for having the best attendance record the last week of 100% - Well done!

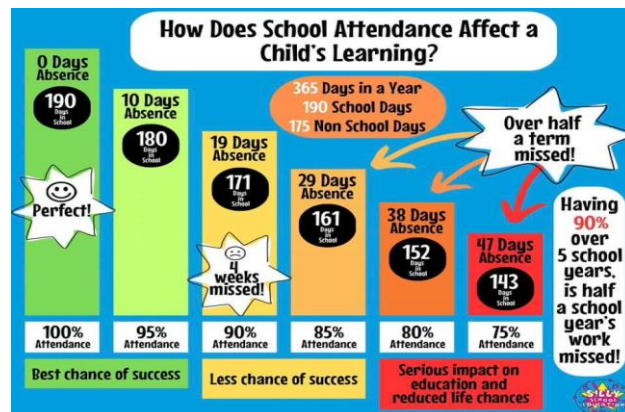
