First Holy Communion Celebration



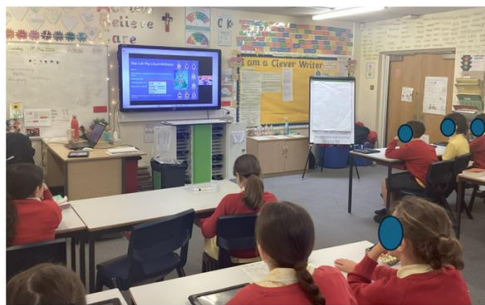
